Students will be able to recognize and name all 26 capital letters of the alphabet.

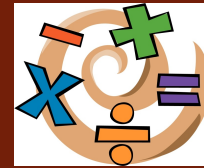
Students will know the sounds of the 26 letters.

We help our Pre-Kindergarten students...

- Recognize & name basic colors: red, orange, yellow, green, blue, black, brown, white, purple, pink
- Recognize & name basic shapes: circle, oval, square, rectangle, triangle, star, heart
- Count to 30
- Write the numbers 1 through 10
- Match the correct number (1-10) to a set of objects

Learning to Work and Play Together

Pre-Kindergarten students begin to

- Demonstrate basic communication skills: making eye contact, listening, and taking turns without interrupting
- Describe ways that they are different and ways that they are alike
- Identify his or her special qualities and discuss a respect for differences
- Identify a variety of feelings, differentiating them from actions or behaviors
- Demonstrate basic social skills: sharing, taking turns, listening, saying "please and thank you," and apologizing

- **the effects of pushing and pulling objects**
- **weather and changes in weather**
- **plants and animals**
