<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Know what is expected of children by grade level.</li> <li>➤ Help kids organize time.</li> <li>➤ Talk &amp; Listen to children about everyday life skills.</li> <li>➤ Communicate with teachers about the whole child.</li> <li>➤ Send child to school prepared for their day (i.e., well rested, healthy, dressed appropriately, informed about what's happening with money, notes, and rides).</li> <li>➤ Discuss &amp; support school/bus rules and consequences.</li> <li>➤ Make an effort to attend meetings and conferences regarding their children.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Provide concrete examples of stages of learning within a grade level throughout the year.</li> <li>➤ Keep parents informed about curriculum.</li> <li>➤ Communicate with parents formally and informally throughout the school year.</li> <li>➤ Set up conferences and meetings to accommodate parents' schedules.</li> <li>➤ Encourage parents to visit school, participate or observe their child's activities, learning, and special events.</li> <li>➤ Get to know each child.</li> <li>➤ Provide students with appropriate learning experiences.</li> <li>➤ Use a variety of methods to assure students' success.</li> <li>➤ Provide an opportunity for students to be included in meetings/conferences.</li> <li>➤ Provide information and training programs which will increase cooperation and trust among students and staff.</li> <li>➤ Be available to listen to and value students' concerns and problems and attempt to make the student feel comfortable.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Come prepared for the school day and with a positive attitude (materials, snacks, lunch, homework, notes, money, appropriate clothing).</li> <li>➤ Ask for help.</li> <li>➤ Do their homework.</li> <li>➤ Talk to parents about their day.</li> <li>➤ Attend regularly and be on time.</li> <li>➤ Take pride and responsibility to do their best work.</li> <li>➤ Organize their time to include both study and play.</li> <li>➤ Search for connections between school and their lives.</li> <li>➤ Respect and understand the responsibility in following school/bus rules and their consequences for choosing not to do so.</li> <li>➤ Communicate concerns or problems to staff.</li> </ul>
